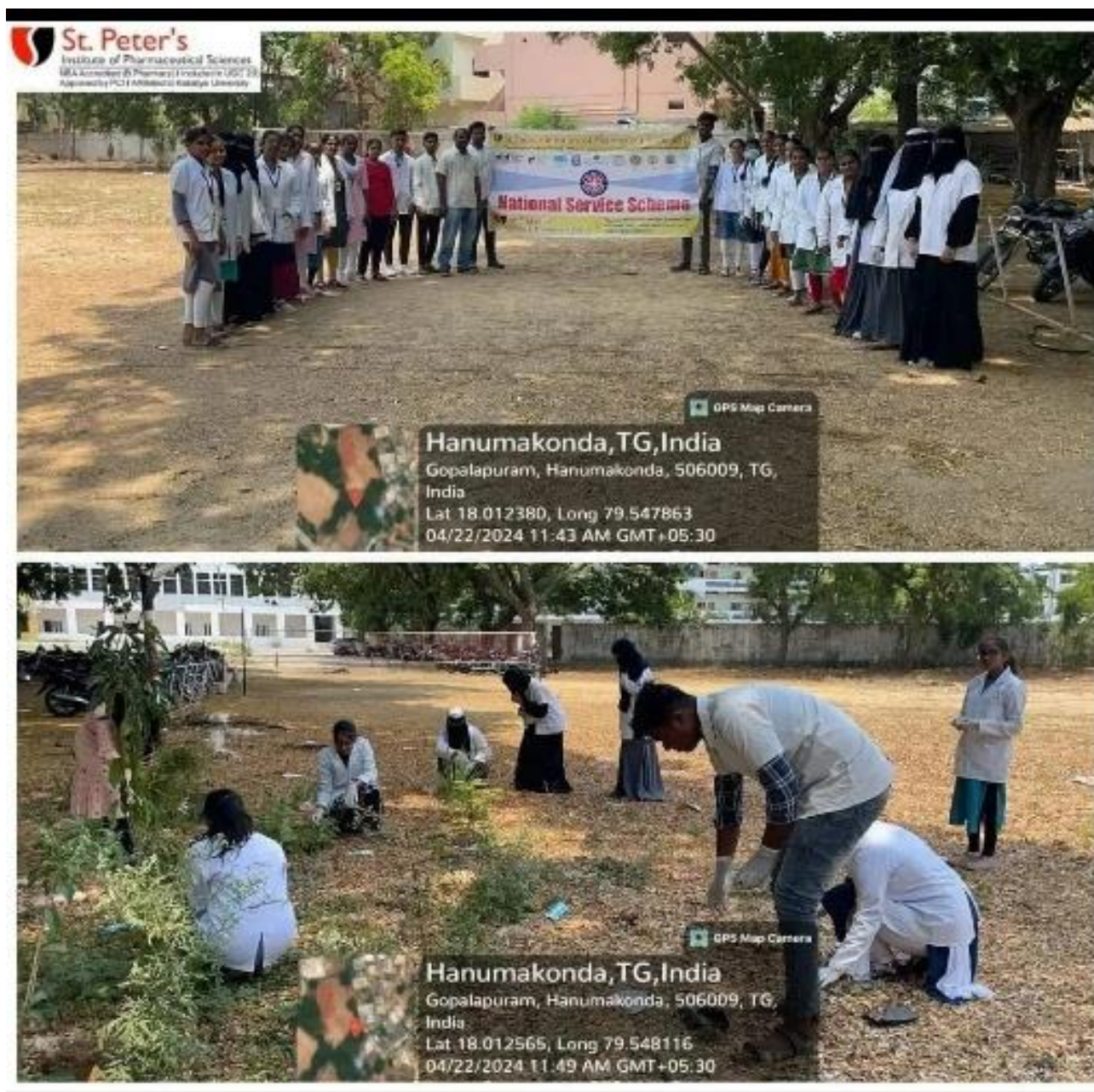






## International Earth Day, NSS
